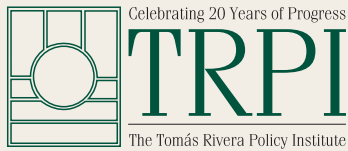

Get the Money You Need!

What are scholarships?

Scholarships are free money that is available to offset the cost of school. Students have to apply for scholarships, which are awarded on a case-by-case basis, often based on merit. If a student receives a scholarship, it does not have to be paid back.

What do you need to have to qualify for a scholarship?

Every scholarship in the following pages has varying requirements — including its own application, which you will need to get and complete — but it is a good idea to pull together a folder of the following information (or as much of it as you can), as almost all scholarships will ask for some combination of these things:

- One or Two Essays
- Letter(s) of Reference
- Writing Sample
- Resume
- Transcripts
- Copy of Student Aid Report (SAR- see below)
- Parent and Student Tax Returns and W-2 Forms
- GPA Certification Form
- Enrollment Verification Form
- Copy of Financial Aid Award Letter

Beware of scholarship scams.

Be wary of scholarship applications that require an “application fee.” Also proceed with caution with scholarship matching services that guarantee results and sales pitches that describe themselves as financial aid workshops or seminars.

Do you need to be a citizen or legal permanent resident to qualify for a scholarship?

Some scholarships require proof of citizenship in order to qualify for a scholarship, but others do not. Lists of both types of scholarships are in the back of this directory.

Where can you get more printed information about paying for college?

Call the federal government for a free guide, in English or in Spanish, to student financial aid: 1-800-4-FED-AID (1-800-433-3243). This guide is an excellent comprehensive “how to” resource.

Are you entering college next year?

Complete the FAFSA as soon as possible.

If you do nothing else, complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), immediately after January 1 of your senior year. It is a form that most schools use to determine financial aid, and money is awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis.

After you submit your FAFSA, you will be sent a Student Aid Report (SAR), which tells how much money your family is expected to contribute to your college education for one year. This helps schools and scholarship organizations know how much money you will need in financial aid.

Padres: ¡ayuden a sus hijos a obtener el dinero que necesitan para asistir la universidad!

¿Qué son las becas?

Las becas ofrecen dinero gratuito para cubrir el costo educativo. El estudiante sólo tiene que solicitar la beca, la cual se otorga mediante el análisis de casos y, a menudo, por mérito. Si un estudiante recibe una beca, no tiene que devolver el dinero.

¿Qué necesitas tener para poder obtener una beca?

Todas las becas que se incluyen en las siguientes páginas tienen distintos requisitos, incluso la solicitud, la cual el estudiante deberá obtener y completar. No obstante, es una buena idea preparar un archivo con la siguiente información (o con la mayor información posible) debido a que todas las becas piden algunas de las siguientes cosas:

- Uno o dos ensayos
- Carta o cartas de recomendación
- Una muestra de escritura
- Un currículum vitae
- Calificaciones escolares
- Copia del informe de ayuda estudiantil (SAR)
- Declaraciones de impuestos del estudiante y de los padres y formularios W-2
- Formulario de certificación del promedio académico (GPA)
- Formulario de verificación de inscripción
- Copia de la carta de asignación económica

¿Se necesita ser ciudadano o residente permanente legal para poder obtener una beca?

Algunas becas requieren que los candidatos sean ciudadanos para poder tener acceso a ellas, pero otras no. Los listados de ambos tipos de becas se encuentran en la parte posterior de este directorio.

Cuidado con las estafas relacionadas con las becas

Tenga cuidado con las becas que requieren una "cuota de solicitud." Asimismo, no se deje engañar por servicios de búsqueda de becas que garantizan resultados ni por aquellos que se describen a sí mismos como talleres o seminarios de ayuda económica.

¿Dónde se puede obtener mayor información impresa sobre el pago de la educación universitaria?

Llame al gobierno federal para obtener una guía gratuita, en inglés o en español, sobre ayuda económica estudiantil: 1-800-4-FED-AID (1-800-433-3243). Esta guía es un recurso integral excelente que incluye información sobre "cómo" solicitar ayuda.

¿Su hijo o hija ingresa a la universidad el año próximo? Complete la solicitud gratuita de ayuda estudiantil federal (FAFSA) lo antes posible.

Si no realiza nada más, complete la solicitud gratuita inmediatamente después del 1 de enero del último año del estudiante. Es un formulario que utilizan la mayoría de las escuelas para determinar la ayuda económica, la cual se le otorga a los primeros que la soliciten.

Luego de presentar el formulario gratuito, recibirá un informe de ayuda estudiantil (SAR), el cual determina el monto de dinero que se espera que su familia contribuya para un año de educación universitaria. Esto ayuda a las escuelas y organizaciones de becas a determinar cuál será el monto de la ayuda económica que necesitará.

About this directory...

This directory contains all regional organizations which the Tomás Rivera Policy Institute (TRPI) could identify that award grants and scholarships targeting California Latino students.

Additionally, TRPI has included the largest national organizations (in total dollars awarded) that grant scholarships for which California's Latino students may qualify.

TRPI acknowledges that new scholarship opportunities are becoming available on a continual basis, and urges readers to submit new scholarship listings or corrections to TRPI.

TRPI also encourages students to check for scholarships from colleges or universities they are attending, as specific scholarships may be available that are not listed in this directory.

Developing this directory...

In 2005 the TRPI undertook a study to identify all the organizations in Southern California where Southern California Latino students and parents could receive information about, or apply for, college scholarships and grants.

Among the outcomes of the study was a recommendation for organizations to actively disseminate hard copies of online data, as the online scholarship search process was found to be time-consuming and complicated.

The difficulties of online scholarship searches were furthermore found to be compounded by the reality that many Latino households do not have Internet access. Any online search is likely to be undertaken at a library or school, where time on a shared computer is limited.

In 2006, in response to these findings, TRPI commissioned the development of this printed scholarship directory.

It should be noted that, while TRPI researchers recognized that there would be value in including all organizations, nationally, to which Latino students could apply for scholarships, such an undertaking was beyond the scope of the project.

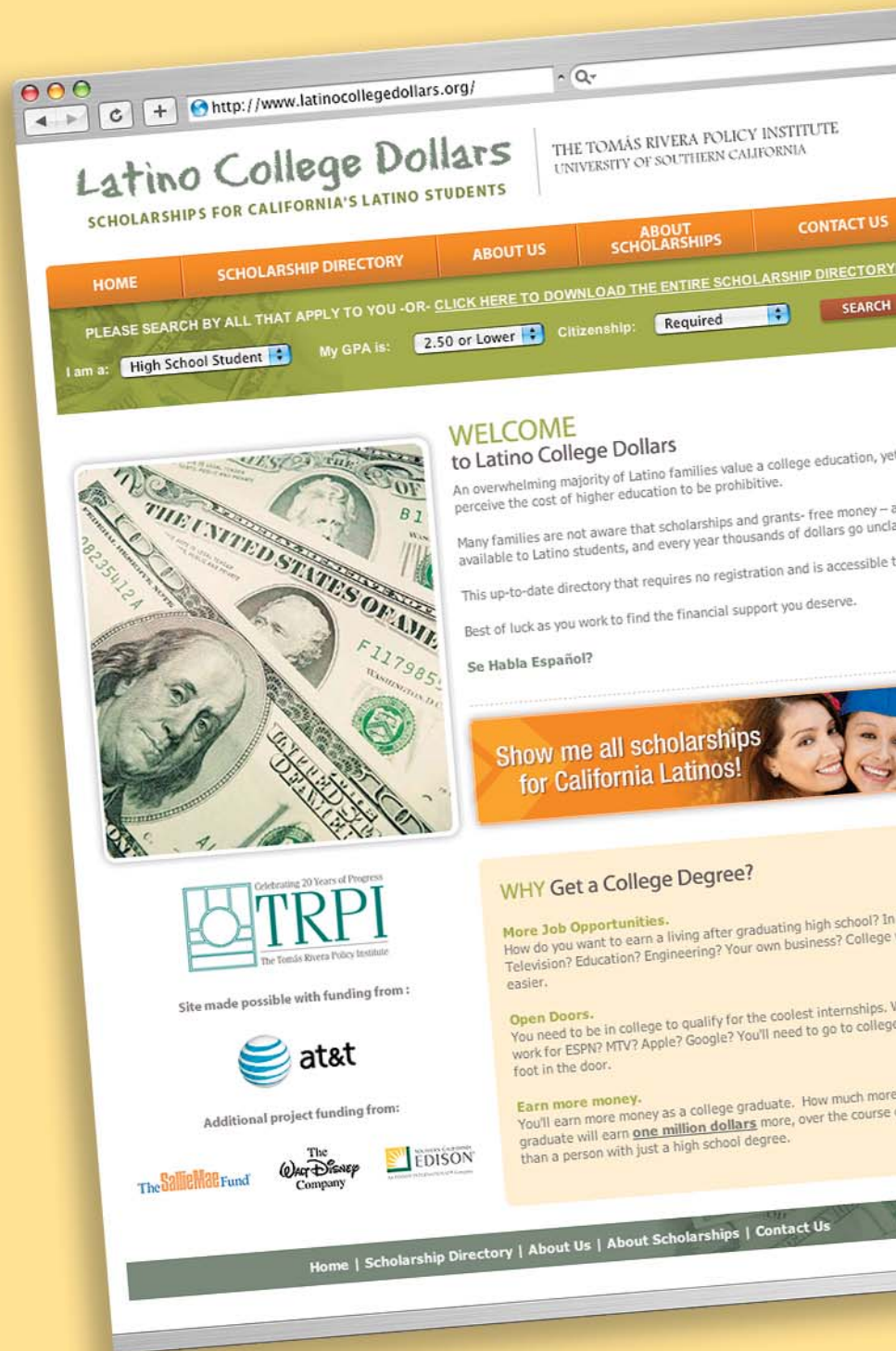

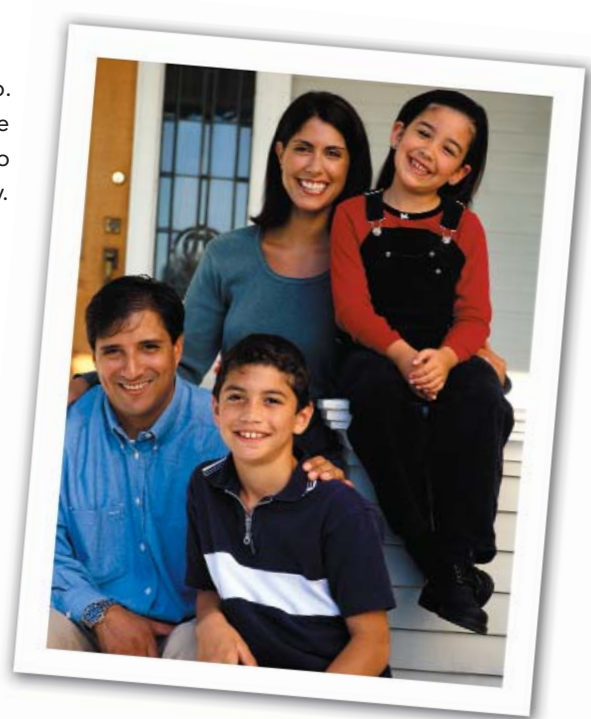

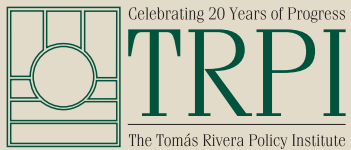
